

Hello PMS Families,

Dr. Fitzgerald did a global call tonight to let families know that we would be returning to our hybrid model on January 11th for families that selected hybrid for the first semester. For families that have selected the remote option, children will continue in the remote model. It is important to note that if you selected hybrid for the second semester, the second semester starts February 1st. The learning calendars for the rest of the school year are linked [here](#). The learning schedule is linked [here](#). Wednesdays are deep cleaning days and no students will be in the building on these days. It is important to note that on Wednesdays on the learning calendars that are not filled in with blue or gold are days that students will be given independent work to do by noon for all seven class periods. Remote only students may join in on office hours with their teachers for support, but it is not mandatory for them to join Zoom unless their teacher requests it or your child needs the support. Our hybrid students are getting this support time in their schedule when they come into the building. However, we want to stress that students may contact their teachers at any time for support.

As we begin our hybrid model again, we want to provide the following reminders:

- You must complete the self-assessment screener with your children before they come into school. The self-assessment screener is linked [here](#).
- Students must wear masks in the building and follow the 6' social distancing rule.
- Students are to bring in their charged Chromebook, their charger, and their headphones/earbuds.
- Students may get a free, grab-and-go breakfast upon arrival.
- Students may order a free, grab-and-go lunch (lunch is taken home to be eaten there).
- It is advised that students bring a labeled water bottle.

We are working on any changes families wanted to make for the second semester (starting February 1st). Once we have completed these changes in our database, we will be communicating hybrid group information or any other pieces of information you may need at a later date.
