



## AFE Remote Learning Information



In the event that school is closed and the district moves to a remote learning day, families will be notified through an automated call from our superintendent, Dr. Alois. For Allen Frear students to be marked present on these days, students must log onto their scheduled Zoom sessions with their teacher (see attached page for directions) starting at 9:00am. **Elementary Inclement Weather Remote Learning Student Day**

Due to inclement weather, we will use a remote day of instruction for your child. Students should follow the directions here to access daily activities.

1. Log on to your child's Chromebook with their username and password.
2. Have your child log on to Clever ([clever.com/in/crk12](https://clever.com/in/crk12)) and click on the Schoology Icon.
3. Students will then click on "**Courses**" to find their **Language Arts Class**.
4. Look for the **Daily Learning Template** to find your links, activities, and schedule for the day.



Teachers will provide a minimum of 15 minutes of live instruction per subject area and either provide additional work for students to complete independently or stay on a live Zoom and continue the work with students. Teachers will be available to support students who are working independently.

Here are additional activities for independent student practice. Please feel free to message your child's teacher through Schoology Messaging, email, or by calling the school for additional information or help with any of the activities.

## Caesar Rodney Chromebook Procedures

The Caesar Rodney School District understands the need to provide a plan to support the 1:1 initiative in the district. For the 2022 - 2023 school year, all students in grades 6 - 12 will be issued a Chromebook to use for the school year and will be expected to take it to and from school every day and it will be charged from home at night. Students in grades K - 5 will also be issued a Chromebook, which can remain in the classroom overnight unless there is an anticipated need to send it home.

In the event your child's Chromebook is accidentally damaged, families must pay a \$20 fee for repairs. If additional damages are caused, the family will be responsible for all fees associated with the repair and/or replacement. See below for costs.

In the event of the following, please talk to your administrator to be issued a replacement:

- Theft (must be reported to the police and a copy of the police report must be shared with the district)
- Fire, Flood, Natural Disaster (claim must be shared with the district)
- Power Surge

Families will be responsible to pay for any parts or replacements due to the following:

- Loss
- Intentional Misuse and Abuse
- Graffiti or personal stickers placed on the outside or inside of chromebook

Students are responsible for notifying their teacher if the Chromebook is damaged immediately. If the damage is deemed an accident, the student will be issued a loaner Chromebook while their device is being repaired.
