



Caesar Rodney Accidental Protection Plan Agreement

The Caesar Rodney School District understands the need to provide a plan to support the 1:1 initiative in the district. Starting in the 2020 - 2021 school year, all students in grades 6 - 12 will be issued a Chromebook to use for the school year and will be expected to take it to and from school every day and it will be charged from home at night. Students in grades Pre K - 5 will also be issued a Chromebook, which will remain in the classroom overnight unless there is an anticipated need to send it home.

In order for students to be issued a Chromebook, families must pay the \$20 non-refundable fee each year. Chromebooks must be returned in the same condition as they were issued at the end of the school year or prior to the student withdrawing from the school. Any unreturned Chromebooks will be reported as stolen.

As a district, we understand that devices can be broken, so this plan will provide support for families and the district should an incident occur. In addition, the fee will also provide each student with their own case to carry the device that the student will be able to keep and use year after year.
