



















Directions for Chromebook Cameras and Artsonia

<p>***** If you need to take a picture</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. In the search bar at the bottom of screen for the computer type in Camera. 		
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 2. Select App and a frame will appear showing you in camera. 		
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 3. Click the Camera icon so it has a white circle like the picture. Same button to take picture. Picture will appear in bottom right corner where the gray box is. Double Click this box. 		
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 4. Once the picture is taken, double click the gray box in bottom right(yours will have a picture in it). 		
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 5. This will bring up your picture. In the top right is three dots. Click it and it will say copy and move to. 		
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 6. You will first click the Copy, then you will click the three dots again and then click on Move to.
