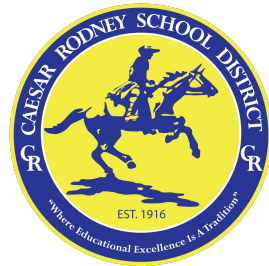

- Proposed plan and dates
- Following the current status of reported positive COVID cases in area
- If there should be an increase in community spread or a change in the Governor's order
- The health and safety of our students and staff are at the forefront of our decision-making, and this plan may need to be revisited based on current conditions.



Consideration for Hybrid Plans

- Feedback from staff and families....equity across the program but only if risks can be mitigated
- **Suggested** start dates provide time to evaluate and refine processes
 - dates may need to be revised
- About 70% of students on hybrid
 - currently, approx. 35% on A or B days
- hybrid plans to support instruction and services at each school
 - routines/schedules to support mask wearing
 - benefits of synchronous and asynchronous learning
 - routines and inclusion at schools

Supporting our Hybrid Plan



- Student mask use
- Social distancing measures
- Practicing appropriate processes (such as arrival/dismissal, meals, movement, etc.)
- Sufficient supply of PPEs
- Ability to mitigate risks
- Essentially having 3 plans in place
 - Hybrid AA/BB
 - Hybrid 4-day
 - Remote



Hybrid Plan: Phases 1 and 2

Phase 1 (current)

- Full-time adult interns with Project SEARCH at DeIDOT

Phase 2:

- Full-time adult interns with Roads to Success at Wesley College
 - started this week: Nov. 2 with internships at Wesley College and off campus
 - 4 days/week: M, T, Th, F with remote on Wednesdays
 - Full days utilizing DART Paratransit

Hybrid Plan: Phase 3



Phase 3:

- John S. Charlton offsite
 - EC/Elem/Middle: Nov. 16: 1 week after middle schools return for hybrid
 - High: Nov. 30: 1 week after HS returns (not including Thanksgiving week)

- John S. Charlton onsite
 - Elem/Middle/High/Adult: Nov. 16
 - Some onsite internships (such as Food Bank)

- KEILC: follows the elementary school schedules
 - follows the schedule for inclusion and transition opportunities with Simpson
 -



How can you support mask wearing?

- Encourage your children by making mask-wearing fun:
 - “practicing with a favorite stuffed animal”
 - “putting on flavored lip balm so the student likes the smell”
 - “buying masks with characters or images that the student likes”
 - “using social stories, and other creative ideas”
- Focus on increasing the “time and tolerance” of wearing a mask
 - doesn’t have to be all day at first; build up over time
- Consider accessories for proper mask-fitting
- Frequent prompting, modeling, and reinforcing

What if students do not wear masks (all day)?

- Frequent handwashing by staff and students
- cleaning protocols every 2 hours
 - classroom staff support in between
 - get students involved in the process
- If at least 3 (to 6) feet cannot be maintained, utilization of PPEs
- Outside opportunities for fresh air breaks

- Contact tracing
 - Staff sign-ins
- Cleaning Protocols
 - electrostatic sprayers
- Bus Transportation
 - trialing thermometer checks starting Thursday, Nov. 5
 - some students may not be able to wear masks

Well/Non-well Areas



- Nurses' Office/Station: students/staff who are well
- Isolation room: used for all students/staff who are not well/sick
- Potential cases
 - Discretion
 - Handled mainly through DPH, nurses, and DO



1 Hour Delay Schedule

- New Delay Schedules
 - Students will come to school on 1 hour delay days.
 - If there is a need for a 2 hour delay, both students and staff will follow their normal schedule and work and learn remotely.

 - Students arrive at 10:20
