1. Adoption: New CRHS Course AP Physics B1

Enclosed with the agenda is a copy of the proposed AP Physics B1 Curriculum for CRHS. The AP Physics B1 course would be an additional option in the high school Science Department. The course is an algebra based course that models the first semester of college physics for non-physics/math/engineering majors. The curriculum for an AP course is standardized and does not allow for any local customization. The course has been approved by the Math/Science Council and Curriculum Cabinet and is being recommended for Board approval by the Division of Instruction.

2. Adoption: New CRHS Course Spanish II Essentials

Enclosed with the agenda is a copy of the proposed Spanish II Essentials Curriculum for CRHS. The Spanish II Essentials course would serve as a follow up course to Spanish I Essentials. Spanish I and II Essentials are alternatives to Spanish I and Spanish II which allow students to earn the World Language credit needed for graduation. The course has been approved by the Humanities Council and Curriculum Cabinet and is being recommended for Board approval by the Division of Instruction.

3. Adoption: New CRHS Course Arabic III

Enclosed with the agenda is a copy of the proposed Arabic III Curriculum for CRHS. Arabic III was offered as an additional option in the World Language Department. This curriculum has been approved by the Humanities Council and Curriculum Cabinet and is being recommended for Board approval by the Division of Instruction.
