

Good evening, this message is from Brook Castillo, principal of McIlvaine Early Childhood Center.

First & foremost I hope all of you are staying healthy! I appreciate your patience as I have a lot of information to share with you this evening.

If you were absent on our last day of school, Friday, March 13th and would like to pick up the folder that was sent home with students please call our main office to schedule an appointment for pick-up or to share your email address so we can email you the documents. The packet included Clever log-in instructions as well as your child's username and password, some writing journal activities, letter cards, sight word cards, and a baggy with scissors, crayons, and a pencil for your child to work at home.

I know parents are concerned with their child's learning and academic progress during this time. We have loaded some resources to our website that will help students continue to practice what they have been working on this school year. You can do this in a few different ways:

First, you can log onto your child's online learning portal, Clever, and use the programs to practice math, reading, comprehension, and phonics. Your child's log-in information was sent home on Friday, March 13th on a purple piece of paper in a yellow folder. If you are unsure of how to log in to clever we have posted a video to our website. Additionally, if you are unable to locate your child's log in information feel free to contact the school and we will provide you with your child's username and password.

Second, we have uploaded a packet of worksheets to our website. These are worksheets that can be done at your own pace. There is no need to worry about turning them in at the end, these are just for practice! If you are unable to print a packet at home please give us a call and we will print a packet for you and schedule a time for you to stop by and pick it up from the school.

You can also check out our website for other resources such as how to talk about the Coronavirus with your little ones and help reduce any anxiety or fear they might be feeling.

Finally, kindergarten registration for the 2020-2021 has been postponed at this time. We will be doing a pre-registration for families to help get the process started. Please check out our website for more information about how you can preregister.
