

Hand Sanitizer Information

Opt Out & Assistance with Self-Use Forms

Dear Rider Families,

This information is related to the use of hand sanitizer and hand washing in our schools. We are providing opportunities for more frequent hand washing with soap and water, and access to hand sanitizer containing at least 60% ethanol or 70% isopropyl alcohol content, as recommended by the CDC.

We understand that the use of hand sanitizer may present issues for some students.

Under the Department of Education's Emergency Order regarding Regulation [817 Medications and Treatments](#), parents/guardians are **not required** to provide permission for their student to use hand sanitizer. Parents, however, **may indicate** to the school that they *do not* want their student using hand sanitizer or that their child may need assistance with self-use.

At our schools, we will promote hand hygiene by:

- Supporting daily routines for students and staff to wash hands, especially at key times; including after bathroom breaks, before lunch, and after playing outside.
- Providing hand sanitizers with at least 60% alcohol (as recommended by the CDC) for teachers, staff, and students. Hand sanitizers may be placed near frequently touched surfaces (e.g. doors, shared equipment) and areas where soap and water are not readily available.
